To enrol to the degree program, graduates from foreign universities must have a knowledge of:

- **Italian** language (details on the Italian test: https://www.unifi.it/vp-10338-non-eustudents.html?newlang=eng#italian)
- English language at level B2.

HOW TO PROVE ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT A.A. 2019/2020

In order to prove their knowledge of English language, applicants from foreign universities have to provide one of the following certificates:

- B2 level certificate issued by the CLA (Centro Linguistico di Ateneo) of the University of Florence (for more information: https://www.cla.unifi.it/vp-363-certificates-of-proficiency.html);
- B2 level certificate issued by one of the following institutions: Cambridge ESOL; City and Guilds (Pitman); Edexcel/Pearson Ltd; Educational Testing Service (ETS); English Speaking Board (ESB); International English Language Testing System (IELTS); Pearson LCCI; Pearson EDI; Trinity College London; Department of English, Faculty of Arts University of Malta; National Qualifications Authority of Ireland Accreditation and Coordination of English Language Services (NQAI ACELS); Ascentis; AIM Awards. (Decree of the Italian Ministry of Education MIUR 22/07/2015 prot. N. 0000787).
- One of the following certificates equivalent to B2 level: University of Cambridge ESOL
 Examinations (starting from First Certificate, FCE); International English Language Testing
 System (IELTS, starting from level 5.5); Trinity College of London (starting from level ISE II);
 Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL, starting from 80).

REMARK: no other certificates will be taken into account.
